- Unwanted Caesarean sections.

Such practices not only jeopardize patient safety but also contribute significantly to rising healthcare costs and increased out-of-pocket expenditure for patients thereby defeating the very concept of affordable accessible healthcare.

In view of the above, to affirm their accountability for the same, an integrity commitment in form of a pledge (attached) may be administered to all medical professionals of your association. Also, the pledge form may be uploaded on the association website.

This pledge will reinforce the collective commitment of India's healthcare community towards "Safer Practices, Safer Care, and Zero Harm." Together, as an association let us advocate towards building a healthcare system that is safer, more compassionate and affordable for every citizen.
